The **driver selection process** has been a major challenge in getting a suitable pool of drivers. The main elements that summarize the process are as follows:

Drivers hired in 5 different groups:

- 70% drivers with license and "diploma" hired in 3 groups: complementary certificate training.
- 30% **candidates to drivers**: license training + complementary certificates
- Total duration of the process: approx. 1 year

The training content of the complementary certificates includes:

- -Rolling Stock (s109)
- -Infrastructure (Eje 12, 13 y 14)
- -On-board equipment (ETCS, LZB y Asfa D.)
- -SGS / Rule book
- -Module in Human Factors: Runovers, emergencies and catastrophes, non-technical skills,
- -Management and prevention of stress, prevention of addictions, ...

Challenges faced:

- -Demanding deadlines
- -Access to rolling stock in the authorization process
- -Access to infrastructure training
- -Training carried out abroad

Found solutions y Key Factors:

- Work carried out with several Training Centres: Captrain, Trenitalia, CEFF, Transfesa, Renfe
- Collaboration of the sector as a whole: AESF, ADIF, Training Centres, Manufacturer (Alstom-Hitachi), specialized contractors (Human Factors Psiconnea ESM).
- Complement to drivers training in the commercial simulation phase with trains without passengers
